The conference begins at 2:00pm on April 16th and continues through to 9:00am on April 18th. We encourage participants and their parents to visit the UCD Picnic Day festivities and downtown Farmers’ Market Saturday morning.

This conference offers high school 4-H members a safe taste of college life and a valuable chance to experience the campus of the University of California, at Davis. While on campus, students will be given a chance to:

- Attend classes
- Tour the campus
- Experience the food, dorms, and other highlights of college life.

Upon the receipt of the completed registration packet, including the application form, medical release form, code of conduct, and a \$55 check, a notification of receipt will be sent. A detailed program guide and schedule will be mailed to accepted participants.

Two days/nights housing, all meals, parking permits, and all registration costs are included in the conference fee. Information about travel by air, bus and train terminals available upon request. Space is limited, so get your forms in as soon as possible! We give priority to on-time applications from Juniors and Seniors, but we usually have room for everyone.

2009 4-H You See Davis Days Conference Details

1. Participants must be high school students or of equivalent age (14-19 years old).
2. Participants must be currently enrolled as 4-H members in the California 4-H YD Program.
3. Participants are asked to arrive on the afternoon of Thursday, April 16th (approximately 2pm) at the UCD Buehler Alumni Center. Map provided in the acceptance letter.
4. The conference will end the morning of April 18th (approximately 9am) with pickup at the State 4-H Office, DANR Building, UC Davis.
5. Given the usual spring weather in Davis, we may be doing a lot of walking and/or bicycle riding in the rain or warm weather. Be prepared with a jacket and a good pair of walking shoes.
6. We will offer walking tours of the campus (which is extensive) as well as provide opportunities for participants to sit in on classes and have some time to view UC Davis on their own.
7. All Collegiate 4-H'ers are registered Yolo County 4-H Volunteer Leaders.
8. Attendees will be split into small groups and housed with current UCD students in their dorm rooms and/or off-campus residences.
9. Some meals will be eaten in the residence halls' dining commons, while others will be provided by the Collegiate 4-H'ers (i.e. pizza, sandwiches, etc.). Please let us know if you have special dietary requirements.
