**---To help the SGV 4-H Fair in its setup, operations, judging, cleanup, and so on, the following has been implemented this year:**

If a club member/adult enters from the **North San Gabriel or South San Gabriel districts, one adult and one youth are required from the club to help out at the SGV 4-H Fair.**

If a club member/adult enters from the **San Fernando Valley or Antelope Valley districts or any club in San Bernardino and Riverside Counties, one adult is required and one youth is recommended from the club to help out at the SGV 4-H Fair.**

Each club that has entries at the SGV 4-H Fair should have a designated adult to pick up their clubs entries at the end of the fair on Sunday. **Any fair entries that are left at the end of the fair may be donated or thrown away.**

**---All tabs in the Concession Booth and Auction Table must be paid prior to the end of the SGV 4-H Fair.**

**--- No visiting near the fair entries during judging. (Signs will be put up as well as the area roped off)**

**--- Camping on the Chino Fairgrounds during the San Gabriel Valley 4-H Fair will be permitted only if there is an adult Camp Director on site.**

**---No large or small livestock will be released until all pens & cages are removed & the Areas are completely cleaned. Release time for other exhibits –after Award Program Sunday, approximately 4 pm. NO EXECPTION!**
