

San Gabriel Valley 4-H Fair Dog Show Sunday April 26th

Registration at 9:00 am - at CHINO JR. FAIRGROUND (on Edison Ave. just East of Central)

1. Must show verification of current rabies, parvovirus & distemper shots before show.
2. All dogs entered in obedience must wear well-fitting chain collars. Fancy, chained, spiked or other special training collars or collars that do not fit properly are not permitted.
3. Leashes - 6' long in fabric or leather. **No** chain leashes.
4. Scores in Novice Y classes will not be counted for High Point awards.
5. Only 1 obedience class per member and dog team is allowed.
6. Classes may be eliminated or combined depending on entries/judge availability.
7. List member age as 1/1 current yr. & dog age 4/1 on entry form.
8. All Dogs must be on leash & no dogs allowed in building, small or large livestock areas.
9. Members are responsible for their dog's behavior while on fairgrounds & may be excused from show & grounds at discretion of Judge/Fair Chairmen or Directors.
10. Members are required to clean up after their own dogs.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Division 400 Beginning Novice -- member trained dog has never won a leg at AKC/ASCA licensed show or trial. All exercises done on leash.

Division 405 Novice A -- Member whose dog has not earned a C.D. degree. Heeling exercise is done on and off leash.

Division 410 Graduate Novice -- dog has earned a C.D. degree-member has not completed C.D.X. degree. Exercises on and off leash.

Division 420 Open -- dog has earned C.D. degree-member trained dogs in open. All exercises off leash, members must supply own wooden dumbbell and jumps.

Division 425 Utility-- dog has earned a C.D.X. degree-member trained dog in utility. All exercises off leash, members must supply own set of 5 leather and 5 metal articles, 3 white gloves and jumps.

Class 1 Junior -- ages 9 - 11

Class 2 Intermediate -- ages 12 - 13

Class 3 Senior -- ages 14 - 18

SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

Division 440 - judging based on AKC Jr. Showmanship

Class 1 Junior, 9-11, with puppy under 12 months

Class 2 Junior, 9-11, with adult dog 12 months and over

Class 3 Intermediate, 12-13, with puppy under 12 months

Class 4 Intermediate, 12-13, with adult dog 12 months and over

Class 5 Senior, 14-18, with puppy under 12 months

Class 6 Senior, 14-18, with adult dog 12 months and over

TRICK DOG

Division 435 - Judging based on handler's skill or command and presentation, the quickness and precision of dog's response, grooming and condition of dog, appearance of handler. Costume for dog is optional but if used, will be considered part of performance.

Class 1 Beginning level - series of 4 tricks

Class 2 Intermediate level - series of 6 tricks

Class 3 Advanced level - series of 8 tricks

EDUCATIONAL DISPLAYS

Division 430 - posters, charts, models, etc. No live animals.

Class 1. Junior - ages 9-11

Class 2. Intermediate - ages 12-13

Class 3. Senior - ages 14-18

Class 4. Junior group - ages 9-11

Class 5. Intermediate group - ages 12-13

Class 6. Senior group - ages 14-18

PRIMARY MEMBERS (up to age 9) -members will do 1 trick and short showmanship and obedience excersises with the help of the judge (if needed)

Division L15 Class 1
